

# JULY 2017 - BRIGHTON - England

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Brighton is the perfect place for students.

Famous for its famous Pier, it is also a bustling city with many things to offer to foreign students. Rich in museums, art galleries, restaurants and shops, Brighton is the ideal place to study and live.

Along with this, the Cultural Experience will also offer technical visits to the famous Universities, so that the student awakens the interest for the culture and the study abroad.

## **What's included:**

1. Health insurance
2. Homestay with full food
3. Custody of the host family for children under the age of 18
4. Transfer from the airport to the cozy house
5. Leveling test
6. Facility Guidance
7. Pedagogical support
8. English classes: 4 hours / day from Monday to Friday, for 2 weeks, in the morning
9. Extracurricular activities in the evening period, from Monday to Friday
10. 1 day excursion on the weekend
11. Certificate of Completion of Course

## **Dates:**

The program will run from July 16 to 29, 2017, with classes from July 17 to 28, 2017.

## **General information:**

1. Departure's day: Saturday - July 15, 2017
2. Arrival day in Brighton: Sunday - July 16, 2017
3. Brighton departure day: Saturday - 29 / July / 2017
4. Day of return to Brazil/Asia/India: Sunday - 30 / July / 2017
5. Course Length: 2 weeks
6. Transfer from the airport to the residence: An official duly identified by the school will be waiting for the students at the landing.
7. Home-school path: Students will travel by foot, bicycle or bus. It's a relatively small city and easy to get around. (Averaging about 20 pounds per week of public transport)

## **Accommodation - In British family homes**

Students will be installed in double rooms, in family houses and will share the bathroom.

Guestrooms include; bedding, desks, and irons / ironing boards.

Bed linen is provided by the family and the bath towel is to be taken by the student.

They receive from the host family the three main meals of the day.

## **Meals: British standard**

All major meals are included in the stay. It is worth mentioning that they are in English standards.

Breakfast: A typical breakfast includes croissant or boiled eggs, cereal, toast, juice, tea or coffee.

Lunch: Students will receive a snack from their families or from the school.

Dinner: Students will eat a warm meal with their host family.

\* Food restrictions must be informed at the time of enrollment.

## **Medical History:**

The Cultural Experience must be notified at the time of enrollment of any medical conditions, allergies or medications that the student may require. Health insurance is included in the price program.

## Other Considerations:

- Curfew: Students must be back in the host family until 9:00 PM and the lights are cleared at 11:00 PM.
- Internet: It is not guaranteed that the warm family has internet at home. However, at school it will be available.
- Phone: Students are allowed to receive calls, always respecting the time zone.

## The Program:

English classes: Students will be taught from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm, Monday through Friday, with classes of a maximum of 16 students.

- Programmatic content: grammar, vocabulary, conversation skills, pronunciation, reading and writing.
- Classroom Materials: Students need to bring their own notebooks and pens. The school will provide students with textbooks and other learning.
- Guided Activities: Students will participate in activities every day (Monday through Friday) from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. There are a variety of scheduled activities that will vary according to the number of students and the weather forecast.
- First day: Students will be given a placement test to determine their level of English and will be guided by the program rules and important information, and then referred to their respective classes.
- Attendance: Students must attend all classes and activities. In case of disability, they must inform the school immediately.
- Certificate: Upon completion of the course, the student will receive the Certificate of Completion of the Course.

## Student Welfare Policy and Program Rules:

- Registration Act: parents / guardians will sign the enrollment form, the custody order for minors under 18 and this schedule of the program. They should present two photos of passport or a digital copy in high resolution of the photo of the passport, besides the copy of the passport of the student.

Contract for minors: The minor will sign a contract on the first day of class containing the rules of conduct and penalties in case of infraction. A copy of the contract will be sent to those responsible in Brazil, upon request.
